- 1) All Parties Hurriyat Conference has expressed serious concern over the arrest spree unleashed by Indian police and troops across Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir to create a sense of fear among the people and force them to give up their just freedom struggle.
- 2) The APHC spokesman in a statement issued in Srinagar said the Indian forces' personnel have arrested dozens of people including leaders of Jamaat-e-Islami during house raids and cordon and search operations in Srinagar, Badgam, Pulwama, Islamabad, Kulgam, Shopian, Baramulla, Bandipora, Rajouri and other districts of the occupied territory in the last few days. He said, the occupation authorities have booked many of the arrested persons including religious leaders, Maulana Abdul Rasheed Dawoodi, Maulana Mushtaq Ahmad Veeri and Abdul Majeed Dar Almadni, under draconian law, Public Safety Act.
- 3) The occupation authorities once again disallowed senior APHC leader, Mirwaiz Umar Farooq, to offer the Juma prayers at historic Jamia Masjid in Srinagar. The Mirwaiz has been under continued illegal house detention since 5th August 2019 when Modi-led fascist Indian government repealed the special status of IIOJK.
- 4) As part of its settler colonialism agenda in IIOJK, Modi regime has intensified the process of granting land ownership rights to non-state subjects. In its latest move, the Modi regime is granting land ownership rights to Hindu refugees who had migrated from Pakistan post partition in 1947 and settled in different areas of the territory. These Hindu refugees, known as West Pakistan refugees as they had migrated from then what was called West Pakistan, had not been given the ownership rights as they were not the State Subjects of IIOJK.
- 5) In Geneva, Kashmiri representatives Altaf Hussain Wani, Syed Faiz Naqshbandi, Sardar Amjad Yousaf Khan, Ms Shameem Shawl and Ms Saira Shah taking part in general debate during the ongoing 51st session of the UN Human Rights Council urged the world body to appoint a Commission of Inquiry to investigate the grave human rights violations perpetrated by Indian troops in IIOJK. They also urged the Council to utilise the UN mechanisms to protect the life and dignity of the people of the occupied territory.
- 6) A group of protesters disrupted the Jaipur Literature Festival in New York event over the presence of a Bharatiya Janata Party leader, Shazia Ilmi, saying that she represented genocide of Muslims and deep betrayal. Earlier, three writers had withdrawn from the event over the presence of BJP spokesperson, Shazia Ilmi.

- 1) In Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir, Indian police in its ongoing crackdown against the freedom-loving Kashmiri people arrested senior Hurriyat leader and noted religious preacher, Maulana Sarjan Barkati, in Shopian district, today.
- 2) Maulana Sarjan Barkati's arrest comes two days after three noted religious leaders, Maulana Abdul Rasheed Dawoodi, Mushtaq Ahmad Veeri and Abdul Majeed Dar Almadni, were arrested and booked under black law, Public Safety Act, by the occupation authorities. Maulana Sarjan Barkati shot to prominence during the 2016 mass uprising triggered by the extrajudicial killing of popular youth leader, Burhan Wani, for his distinct style of sloganeering. He was arrested in October that year and subsequently booked under draconian PSA. A cleric and a charismatic crowd puller, Maulana Barkati was released in 2020 after being kept in illegal detention by the occupation authorities for four years.
- 3) All Parties Hurriyat Conference leader, Syed Bashir Andrabi, in a statement issued in Srinagar expressed serious concern over the illegal arrest of Maulana Barkati and other religious leaders. He maintained that such brutal tactics cannot subdue the Kashmiris' resolve for securing freedom from Indian illegal occupation and they will continue their struggle till complete success.
- 4) Muttahida Majlis-e-Ulema, the representative amalgam of religious, social and educational organizations, headed by Mirwaiz Umar Farooq, in a statement strongly condemned the arrests of religious scholars. The High Court Bar Association of IIOJK in a statement in Srinagar demanded immediate release of the arrested religious leaders.
- 5) In Geneva, speakers at an event held on the sidelines of the ongoing 51st session of the United Nations Human Rights Council strongly denounced the ruthless suppression of dissent in Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir by Narendra Modi-led fascist Indian government. They said that since August 5, 2019 crackdown scores of journalists and human rights defenders who have played an important role in documenting human rights abuses committed by Indian troops in the occupied territory have been arrested and booked under black laws. The event was attended and addressed by international law experts, academicians, rights activists, including Alfred De Zayas, Syed Faiz Naqshbandi, Salam, Altaf Hussain Wani, Sardar Amjad Yousuf Khan and Barrister Nida Salam. - 1) The All Parties Hurriyat Conference has denounced crackdown on political activists and religious scholars by Indian forces' personnel in Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir to stifle voice for freedom.
- 2) Service, the APHC spokesman in a statement issued in Srinagar strongly criticized the arrest of prominent religious scholars and pro-freedom leaders Sarjan Barkati, Maulana Abdul Rasheed Dawoodi, Maulana Mushtaq Ahmed Veeri and Abdul Majeed Dar Al Madani under draconian law, Public Safety Act. He called upon the United Nations and global human rights bodies to play their part in placing a check on the fast deteriorating political and human rights situation in occupied Kashmir.
- 3) There is growing resentment among Jammu and valley-based government employees against the Modi government's new recruitment policy, particularly after the revocation of Jammu and Kashmir's special status on August 5, 2019. In order to advance its Hindutva agenda in the occupied territory, the BJP ruled Delhi government has come up with a wicked plan to replace local employees with the activists of Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh and Bharatiya Janata Party. Besides terminating the employees on baseless charges, they are also not provided salaries for months, together, to force them to quit the job. This attitude has forced the local workers to take to the streets to record their protest. In this regard, a sit-in protest of daily wagers entered 88th consecutive day in Jammu, today.
- 4) In London, a number of British lawmakers and Islamic bodies have called on the UK government to ban a Hindu extremist woman, Sadhvi Nisha Rithambara, from entering the country due to her Hindu communal agenda. Rithambara heads the Durga Vahini organization which is the woman's wing of Vishwa Hindu Parishad, one of the close allies of Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi's Bharatiya Janata Party. International rights groups as well as two Labor lawmakers Sam Tarry and Yasmin Qureshi have warned of the potential stoking of communal tensions in the UK if she is allowed to enter Britain.
- 5) In an utter embarrassment to the Indian government's efforts to stop Sikhs' struggle for a separate homeland, the Canadian government led by Prime Minister Justin Trudeau has refused to refrain Canadian Sikhs from expressing their views through Khalistan Referendum voting. A Canadian government official said this in Toronto in response to the consistent lobbying by the Indian government against the rising pro-Khalistani sentiment in Canada and the voting for today's Khalistan Referendum at the Gore Meadows Community Center in Brampton, Ontario.

- 1) Muttahida Majlis-e-Ulema headed by Mirwaiz Umar Farooq has strongly condemned the arrest of religious scholars in Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir, saying the detentions were aimed at silencing their voices against the grabbing of thousands of kanals of Waqf land and property.
- 2) Muttahida Majlis-e-Ulema, an amalgam of all religious and social organisations across the Kashmir valley, in a statement issued in Srinagar deplored that the Modi regime has stooped to a new low to arrest innocent ulema under draconian laws like Public Safety Act and Unlawful Activities Prevention Act to rob the Kashmiris of their distinct religious and cultural identity. The MMU pointed out that besides grabbing Waqf land, fresh arrest spree of political activists and religious leaders is meant to pave the way for forcible implementation of Hindutva agenda in IIOJK.
- 3) National Conference has strongly objected to the inclusion of non-local voters in the electoral rolls in Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir, terming it a great threat to the demography. National Conference central leader Rattan Lal Gupta said that the recent announcement of Chief Electoral Officer with regard to induction of new 2.5 million non-local voters is aimed at trampling the rights of the Kashmiri people by the BJP government.
- 4) In New Delhi, the Congress contested its former leader Ghulam Nabi Azad's claim on Article 370 and said that Indian Supreme Court or a new government can strike down the undemocratic, illegal and unconstitutional revoking of Jammu and Kashmir's special status. Congress General Secretary Jairam Ramesh in a statement said that the Congress Working Committee is convinced that the steps taken by the Modi government on August 5, 2019 and thereafter were illegal and unconstitutional and hence do not require a two-third majority of the parliament to revoke them.
- 5) Responding to the growing attacks by Hindu fanatics on innocent Muslims in Leicester, the UK, a renowned Arab journalist, writer and columnist, Abdullah Al Imadi has warned that the Hindu-Muslim tension could engulf the Arab countries which are hosting thousands of Hindu workers who are inspired by the RSS ideology. Al Imadi took to the twitter and said that the attacks on Muslims in Leicester should be considered as an early warning for Gulf Cooperation Council countries.
- 6) The APHC-AJK organized a prayer session in Islamabad, today, to pay tributes to a renowned Kashmiri freedom activist, Ijaz Ahmad Dar on his 32nd martyrdom anniversary.

- 1) Illegally detained All Parties Hurriyat Conference Chairman, Masarrat Aalam Butt and other senior leaders have expressed the hope that the United Nations during its ongoing 77th General Assembly session in New York will come up with a viable formula for final settlement of disputes like Kashmir to lay a strong foundation for a peaceful world.
- 2) Masarrat Aalam Butt and other leaders Shabbir Ahmad Shah, Nayeem Ahmad Khan and Aasiya Andrabi in their statements from New Delhi's Tihar jail said that Kashmir is the oldest global dispute present on the UN agenda, and ceaseless loss of life due to its unaddressed status betrays utter failure of the World Body. The statements, which were released in Srinagar, maintained that desire for a peaceful, progressive and prosperous world would be a daydreaming without resolving the issues like Kashmir involving the political future of the millions of people.
- 3) Muttahida Majlis-e-Ulema, the representative amalgam of religious, social and educational organisations of Kashmir, in a statement in Srinagar strongly objected to the enforcement of singing Hindu hymns in schools in Kashmir, saying it was an attempt to undermine the Kashmiris' religious identity. The MMU, headed by Mirwaiz Umar Farooq, asked people including teachers to defy such diktats that go against the very grain of their religious beliefs and identity.
- 4) India's dreaded State Investigation Agency along with paramilitary Central Reserve Police Force and police raided the office of Falah-e-Aam Trust in Srinagar and Baramulla districts. Founded by Jamaat-e-Islami of occupied Jammu and Kashmir, Falah-e-Aam Trust is running hundreds of welfare schools across the territory. The raids were carried out at the Trust offices in Sopore and Nowgam areas.
- 5) In what locals believe a deliberate attempt by the Modi-led Indian government to cripple the Kashmiris economically, Bangladeshi apple traders have threatened with ceasing the business operation because of unnecessary checking of their fruit-laden trucks at Srinagar-Jammu highway and undue questioning. Speaking to the media in Srinagar, these fruit purchasers expressed regret that they have suffered significant losses due to delaying tactics used by the authorities. They complained that the fruit-laden vehicles take 15 days to reach Bangladesh as against seven days in the past.
- 6) In another anti-education act against the Kashmiri people, the Indian government has cancelled the fellowship of a Kashmiri scholar Javid Ahmad Reshi at Aligarh Muslim University on the charge of pro-freedom fiction writing on his social media posts. Javid Reshi who belongs to Bandipora district was pursuing PhD at the AMU. Earlier, Jamia Millia Islamia, Delhi, had cancelled the admission of a Kashmiri activist, Safoora Zargar on baseless charges.

- 1) Coinciding with the ongoing 77th UN General Assembly Session in New York, the world is observing International Day of Peace, today, which is meaningless for around 15 million Kashmiris who are facing the worst state terrorism let loose by India in occupied Jammu and Kashmir for the past 75 years.
- 2) A report released by Kashmir Media Service in connection with the day, today, said that day-to-day killings including that of top resistance leaders Syed Ali Gilani and Muhammad Ashraf Sehrai in fake encounters and in custody mock the global celebrations of the peace day. The report maintained that 21 September is dedicated to the global peace, but the same continues to elude South Asia for the past more than seven decades due to the free license enjoyed by the brutal Indian occupation troops to carry out massacre of the Kashmiri people with impunity. Indian forces' actions are no less than a holocaust in the occupied territory. Over four thousand Kashmiris including APHC senior leadership are facing illegal detentions while the world community is tightlipped and witnessing with criminal silence the turning of occupied Jammu and Kashmir into a big concentration camp by the RSS-backed Modi government.
- 3) India's ruthless State Investigation Agency continued raids for the second consecutive day in different areas of in Srinagar, Baramulla, Islamabad, Kulgam and Jammu areas. The SIA sleuths are particularly targeting the residences of Jamaat-e-Islami activists and offices of welfare institutions during the raids.
- 4) Indian police arrested a youth during a protest against the Indian film crew of Emraan Hashmi-starrer 'Ground Zero' in south Kashmir's Islamabad district. The police used brute force on the protesters who shouted slogans against the Indian film shooting members in Pahalgam area of the district.
- 5) National Conference President Farooq Abdullah addressing a party convention at Batote in Ramban district assailed the Narendra Modi led India's Hindutva government for wielding delimitation as a weapon to establish its hegemony in the territory. He said the geographical argument put forth by the New Delhiconstituted Delimitation Commission for IIOJK in carving out new constituencies was just a smokescreen and the real aim was to benefit the fascist BJP government. He said BJP stands exposed for its duplicity, deception and self-centered agenda, which has taken a heavy toll on the people's life.

- 1) New Delhi-controlled State Investigation Agency backed by Indian army and police arrested more than 100 innocent people during the ongoing crackdown operations across Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir during the current week. Among those who have been arrested included religious scholars, Hurriyat activists and Jamaat-e-Islami members. The Bharatiya Janata Party-led Indian regime is also targeting journalists, lawyers, students and government employees as a preemptive measure to advance its Hindutva agenda in the occupied territory without any hindrance.
- 2) A court in Jammu issued a production warrant against Jammu and Kashmir Liberation Front chief Muhammad Yasin Malik, directing the authorities of New Delhi's infamous Tihar jail to produce him physically before the court on the next date of hearing in last week of October, in a fake case.
- 3) The OIC Contact Group on Jammu and Kashmir released a declaration at its meeting on the sidelines of the 77th United Nations General Assembly Session in New York calling for unrestricted access of UN, global media and independent observers to occupied Jammu and Kashmir. While asking for settlement of the Kashmir dispute as per UN Security Council resolutions, the OIC Contact Group meeting, chaired by Secretary-General, Hissein Brahim Taha, raised the demand for holding India accountable for heinous crimes in occupied Kashmir.
- 4) In Geneva, Kashmiri representatives while speaking on item 3 General Debate in the United Nations Human Rights Council said the unresolved Kashmir dispute has become a nuclear flashpoint in South Asia due to massive human rights violations by Indian forces in the occupied territory. A seminar titled "Indian Military Repression, Demographic Engineering, religious and civilization aggression in occupied Kashmir" was also held on the sidelines of the 51st UN Human Rights Council session. The speakers asked the United Nations to send teams to IIOJK to see for themselves the plight of Kashmiri people under Indian subjugation.
- 5) As many as 106 activists of the Indian Muslim group, Popular Front of India were arrested, today, during raids by multi-agencies led by the National Investigation Agency on concocted charges.
- 6) An anti-India protest demonstration was held outside the headquarters of the United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC) in Geneva, the capital of Switzerland, to draw attention of the international community towards the Indian state terrorism in Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir.
- 7) The demonstration was organized by Kashmiri delegation attending the ongoing 51st session of the UNHRC and Tehreek-e-Kashmir Europe. The protesters were holding banners and placards with slogans like "India stop state terrorism in

- Kashmir", "Indian Army stop pellet firing in Kashmir" and "Kashmiris want freedom".
- 8) Addressing the protesters, the speakers appealed to the UNHRC session and the world community to take cognizance of the Indian military repression, custodial killings, mass destruction of properties, restrictions on freedom of assembly and expression as well as religious and civilizational aggression by Indian troops in the occupied territory.
- 9) They also expressed solidarity with the victims of Indian state terrorism in the occupied territory and condemned the arbitrary detention of Kashmiri political leaders, religious scholars and human rights defenders. They called upon the UNHRC and other world human rights organizations including Amnesty International, Human Rights Watch and International Committee of Red Cross to play their role in the release of the Kashmiri detainees.
- 10) The speakers included PPP AJK President, Ch Muhammad Yasin, Altaf Hussain Wani, Syed Faiz Naqashbandi, Sardar Amjad Yousaf Khan, Mrs Shamim Shwal, Hassan Al-Bana, Advocate Parvez Ahmad and Faheem Kayani.

- 1. The All Parties Hurriyat Conference has urged the United Nations to shun its indifference towards the Indian brutalities in Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir and fulfill its obligations towards resolving the Kashmir dispute by implementing its relevant resolutions.
- 2. The APHC in a statement issued in Srinagar said that the world leaders attending the ongoing 77th session of the UN General Assembly session in New York must hold India accountable for grave human rights violations being perpetrated by Indian troops in IIOJK. It said that the leaders of powerful countries of the world must come forward in a big way and play their role in the settlement of the Kashmir dispute for ensuring regional and global peace.
- 3. Kashmiri journalist Ruwa Shah has expressed serious concern over the deteriorating health of her father and APHC leader, Altaf Ahmad Shah, illegally detained at New Delhi's infamous Tihar Jail. Ruwa Shah has written a letter to the Indian Prime Minister, Narendra Modi, seeking intervention into the medical negligence faced by her father in the jail. She maintained that her father has been seriously ill since a week now and the family has no information about his whereabouts for the last two days as he has been shifted to some undisclosed location.
- 4. Narendra Modi-led fascist Indian government is hatching conspiracies to grab land and properties across the territory. In its latest move, the BJP in collusion with the Waqf Board intends to snatch the land of Eidgah, Srinagar, which is revered by the Kashmiris for its historical Martyrs' Graveyard.
- 5. The Organization of Islamic Cooperation at the Annual Coordination Meeting of Foreign Ministers of the member states renewed unwavering solidarity with the people of Kashmir and expressed full support for their struggle for securing their inalienable right to self-determination in accordance with the relevant resolutions of the UN Security Council and the OIC, and the wishes of the Kashmiri people. The meeting was chaired by Pakistan Foreign Minister Bilawal Bhutto Zardari at the UN Headquarters in New York on the sidelines of the 77th Session of UNGA.
- 6. In Geneva, Kashmiri delegates during a meeting with the members of the Independent Permanent Human Rights Commission of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation briefed them about the deteriorating political and human rights situation in Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir. They appealed to the OIC rights' body to help stop Indian state terrorism in the occupied territory. The Kashmiri delegation included Altaf Hussain Wani, Syed Faiz Naqshbandi, Sardar Amjad Yousuf Khan, Hassan Al-Bana, Dr Saira Shah and Zaffar Qureshi.
- 7. Several Muslim organizations including Jamaat-e-Islami Hind, Students Islamic Organisation, Social Democratic Party of India, Solidarity Youth Movement,

Welfare Party of India, Campus Front of India, have strongly condemned the massive raids by India's National Investigation Agency and Enforcement Directorate at the offices of Muslim organization, Popular Front of India, and houses of its leaders across India. In a massive crackdown, over 100 top leaders and functionaries of the PFI were arrested by the Indian agencies yesterday. Fourteen of those arrested have been booked under sedition on the charges of waging war against India.
