zad Jammu and Kashmir President Barrister Sultan Mehmood Chaudhry has said that any aggression against AJK or misadventure by India would be responded in the same coin. While addressing the 9th convocation ceremony of the State-run University of Azad Jammu and Kashmir as a special guest in the State metropolis on Thursday, President Barrister Sultan, also the Chancellor of state-run universities in Azad Jammu Kashmir, while referring to Kashmiris' resilience in the face of Indian state terrorism said that the people of the occupied Kashmir



were a new history of resistance. "The morale of the Kashmiri people is high, our struggle will continue till the independence of occupied Kashmir from Indian rule", he said.

US Urges India To Restore Political Rights In IIOJK

he United States has urged the Narendra Modi-led Indian government to restore local

elections and political rights in all the regions across Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir (IIOJK). In a statement, Assistant Secretary of State for South and Central Asian Affairs Donald Lu made it clear that there has been no change in the American policy on Kashmir. He said the US has discussed human rights violations in India, especially in Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir at



high level with New Delhi. He further said the solution to the Kashmir issue is possible only through direct negotiations between India and Pakistan. Donald Lu stated that it should be ensured that the media could continue to do its job in Kashmir.

Universal Periodic Review at UNHRC frustrates India

Pakistan's effective campaign at the UN Human Rights Council (UNHRC) highlighting India's worst human rights record and brutalities in Indian illegally occupied Kashmir

has frustrated New Delhi. India's human rights record came under scrutiny during the ongoing 4th cycle of the Universal Periodic Review (UPR) in the UNHRC in Geneva. The UPR is a peer review process where states offer recommendations to the country under review to improve its human



rights record. Pakistan on the occasion urged India to reverse its illegal steps taken since August 5, 2019 in IIOJK and cease demographic engineering in the territory. Pakistan called upon New Delhi to demonstrate its commitment to international law and implement the UN resolutions on Kashmir. It also urged India to accept recommendations made in the Kashmir reports by the Office of the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights and allow the independent observers to visit the occupied territory.

UN To Examine India's HR Record Wednesday As Stakeholders Blow Away Its Smoke Screen

The United Nations is set to examine the human rights record of India on November 10

as the human rights organizations, in their reports, have already exposed its ruse of a secular polity with "serious regression" in human rights and constitutional protections under the BJP-led government. The UN Human Rights Council's Universal Periodic Review (UPR) Working Group would examine India's human rights record for the



fourth time in its session taking place from November 7-18 which marks the beginning of the UPR fourth cycle. India's first, second and third UPR reviews took place in April 2008, May 2012 and May 2017, respectively. The URP is a unique process involving a review of the human rights records of all UN member states which provides the opportunity for each state to declare what actions they have taken to improve the human rights situations in their countries. In its report submitted to the UN, the Indian government claimed it to being firmly committed to the promotion and protection of human rights with its constitution guaranteeing civil and political rights, justice, liberty, equality, fraternity and individual dignity within a secular democracy.

IIOJK Victim Of New Delhi's Wrong Policies: Congress

S enior Congress leader Ghulam Ahmad Mir has said Jammu and Kashmir is the victim of wrong policies of the BJP-led Indian government which is out to destroy the very foundation of democracy. In a statement, he said Jammu and Kashmir lost its identity under BJP and appealed to the people to support it for the fight for the restoration of statehood. He said people are being exploited in the name of bright future, control on prices, and 20



million jobs annually, but all their promises have fallen flat, except politics of hate and division.

India Cannot Change Kashmir's Disputed Status through Its Military Presence: APHC

The All Parties Hurriyat Conference has said that Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir is the highest militarized zone in the world as over one million Indian troops remain deployed in cities, towns and villages to suppress the Kashmiri people brutally. The APHC in a statement issued in Srinagar said that brutal militarization has created a humanitarian crisis in the occupied territory, which is under direct military siege particularly after New Delhi illegally revoked Jammu and Kashmir's special status in August 2019. The APHC said huge Indian military build-up has made the territory a giant open-air prison for its residents. Meanwhile, APHC leaders Khawaja Firdous and Syed Bashir Andrabi in a joint statement in Srinagar strongly condemned the confiscation of properties of Hurriyat leaders and workers by Indian agencies. They said that India was using different tactics to suppress the ongoing Kashmir freedom movement but it would never succeed in its sinister designs. Furthermore, the IIOJK High Court quashed the illegal detention of two persons, booked under black law, Public Safety Act, and directed the authorities to release them immediately.

'India Cannot Change IIOJK's Disputed Status Through Its Military Presence'

ndian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir is the highest militarized zone in the world

as over one million Indian troops remain deployed across the territory to brutally suppress the Kashmiri people. A report released by Kashmir Media Service says brutal militarization has created a humanitarian crisis as the territory is under military siege since India illegally landed its troops in Srinagar on 27 October 1947. It said Kashmiris are engaged in a peaceful political movement and India cannot



change the disputed status of Kashmir through its huge military presence. The report said the Modi regime can't subdue Kashmiris through its military might.

Shabbir Shah Concerned Over Surge In Indian State Terrorism In HOJK

Incarcerated Senior leader of All Parties Hurriyat Conference, Shabbir Ahmad Shah, has expressed serious concern over the surge in Indian state terrorism in Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir. In a message from New Delhi's infamous Tihar jail, he strongly denounced the unabated killing of Kashmiri youth by Indian troops and illegal confiscation of civilians' properties by the occupation authorities. Shabbir Ahmad Shah said innocent people are being harassed and humiliated during cordon and search operations, whereas killing of youth in fake encounters, enforced disappearances and confiscation of civilians' properties are being used by India as a war tactic to suppress Kashmiris' legitimate struggle for right to



self-determination. He appealed the international community to hold India accountable for its brutalities on innocent Kashmiri people.

President Biden Pens Down Letter To Kashmiri Leader, Says Promoting 'Freedom' Integral Part Of US Policy

TS President Joe Biden has said "defending democracy, promoting freedom, human

rights, respecting the rule of law and treating everyone with dignity are the important part of core values of foreign policy of the United States and American society". The US President Biden expressed these views in his recent letter to Raja Muzaffar, a Washington-based veteran Kashmiri leader, according to a message released to the media, here, on Sunday. "The challenges facing our



world today demonstrate how interconnected we are and how the fates of all people are bound together. From famines and climate change to wars and pandemics, no country can solve these shared problems alone, and America cannot afford to be absent from the world stage," the US President further added in his letter while responding to Muzaffar's recent letter inked over the foreign policy of the United States in the context of a comparative review of the occupation of Ukraine and Kashmir.

Kashmiri truck driver beaten in Indian state of Punjab

Kashmiri truck driver was beaten by forces' personnel at toll plaza in Indian state of Punjab. President of IIOJK Truck Operators Welfare Union, Hilal Malik said that the truck driver identified as Sahil Iqbal of Yaripora, Pulwama in Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir was injured after he was beaten by men at toll plaza in Mukerian area of Punjab. The injured driver was admitted to a civil hospital at Mukerian. "We



demand of Punjab police to take strict action against the culprits," he said. Meanwhile, a police official from Mukerian Punjab told media that an FIR has been registered under relevant sections of law and further investigation was going on.

Indian Troops Martyr One More Kashmiri Youth In Shopian District

ndian troops in their fresh act of state terrorism, martyred one more Kashmiri youth in Shopian district of Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir. According to Kashmir Media Service, the troops continued their violent military operations in different areas of Shopian, Kupwara, Baramulla, Bandipora, Islamabad, Pulwama, Poonch and Rajouri districts. The troops



subjected the residents including women and children to harassment and vandalized the household goods during these operations.


APHC Leaders Pay Glowing Tributes to Allama Iqbal on His Birth Anniversary

s the world is observing International Day to End Impunity for Crimes against Journalists, the media persons are facing state repression in Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir (IIOJK) and in India. Indian Troops Martyr Four More Youth In IIOJK
