AJK President Grieves Over Demise Of Jailed Hurriyat Leader Altaf Ahmed Shah



AJK PM Urges World To Resolve Kashmir Dispute



On Kashmir Black Day, OIC Reaffirms "Full Solidarity" With Kashmiri People

The Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) on Thursday reiterated its "full solidarity" with the people of Jammu and Kashmir in their quest for the right to selfdetermination, as they observed Black Day to mark the completion of 75 years of the Indian occupation of the IIOJK. On the occasion, the OIC general secretariat, pursuant to the decisions and resolutions of the Islamic Summit and OIC Council of Foreign Ministers, urged



India to halt and reverse the illegal and unilateral actions taken on August 5, 2019, according to a statement issued by the OIC secretariat in Jeddah.

Pakistan Strongly Rejects Indian Defence Minister's "Gratuitous" Remarks On Kashmir

Pakistan on Friday rejected and strongly condemned the "highly irresponsible, provocative and gratuitous" remarks made by the Indian defence minister at a public event on Kashmir Black Day in Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir (IIOJK). The Foreign Office spokesperson said that the Indian defence minister's statement that "India had begun development work in IIOJK that would not stop till it reaches Gilgit-Baltistan" was utterly absurd and



ludicrous. He said the Indian minister's "delusional" remarks were farcical on the one hand and reflective of India's characteristic hostility towards Pakistan on the other. "The so-called 'development work' in IIOJK is a mere eyewash, while the amateurish attempt to distort the well-established historical facts about the Jammu and Kashmir dispute is pathetic," he remarked.

Pakistan Marks 75 Years Of Indian Illegal And Forcible Occupation Of Jammu And Kashmir

ashmir Black Day was observed on Thursday to condemn 75 years of Indian illegal occupation of Jammu and Kashmir and reaffirm Pakistan's unflinching commitment to the Kashmir cause. 'HOJK's Tumultuous Situation Can Escalate Pak, India Tension'

akistan's Ambassador to the US, Masood Khan, has warned that the prevailing turbulent situation in Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir can lead to escalation of tensions between Pakistan and India. The Pakistani envoy said this in an interview with Newsweek. He said there is a persistent threat that the two countries can use their strategic weapons in case a war erupts. Masood Khan maintained that it was the Indian aggression that had led to the first Indo-Pakistan war. He pointed out that since then the two countries have fought three more major wars with frequent clashes occurring



across the Line of Control in the internationally recognized disputed territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

Pakistan Calls Un To Promote Peaceful Settlement Of Kashmir Dispute

akistan has called on the United Nations to actively promote a peaceful settlement of Kashmir dispute in accordance with Security Council resolutions and the wishes of Kashmiri people. Speaking at the U.N General Assembly, Pakistan's Permenet Representative to the Unitted Nations, Munir Akram said Pakistan desires peaceful relations with all its neighbours, including India but to ensure durable peace in South Asia, the resolution of Jammu and Kashmir dispute is essential. Envoy, describing India's occupation of Jammu and Kashmir as the worst manifestation of modern-day colonialism said for 70 plus years, through force and fraud, India had avoided the implementation of UN resolutions.

According to Kashmir Media Service, Altaf Ahmad Shah, who was son-in-law of the icon of Kashmir freedom movement martyred Syed Ali Gilani, had been languishing in New Delhi's infamous Tihar Jail since his arrest in 2017. He was diagnosed with late stage renal cancer.

SIA Files Chargesheet against Journalist, Phd Scholar In IIOJK

n Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir (IIOJK), the State Investigation Agency (SIA) has filed a chargesheet in a National Investigation Agency (NIA) court in Srinagar against a digital magazine editor and a PhD scholar in a false case. Indian police arrested Prominent Kashmiri journalist Fahad Shah on February 04 under black law, Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA) on the charges of publishing anti-India content.



Similarly, the police on April 17 arrested a PhD scholar of the University of Kashmir, Abdul Aala Fazili, who is also a journalist, for writing an article in an online magazine.

At UN, Pakistan Calls For Resolution Of J&K, Palestine Issues For Lasting Peace

t the United Nations, Pakistan has reiterated that there will be no peace in South Asia and the Middle East until the people of Jammu and Kashmir and Palestine are enabled to exercise their right to self-determination. Speaking in a debate on the rule of law at national and international levels in the UN General Assembly's legal committee, Pakistan's deputy permanent



representative Aamir Khan said the right to self-determination is a fundamental pillar of the world order. He called on the United Nations, particularly the Security Council, to invest more time and energy to secure the implementation of its own resolutions on Palestine and the Jammu and Kashmir disputes.
