Hissein Brahim Taha Pledges OIC's Full Support for Kashmir Cause

OIC Secretary General Hissein Brahim Taha has pledged OIC's full support for the Kashmir cause. In a meeting with the President and Prime Minister of Azad Jammu and Kashmir on Sunday, he expressed his deep sentiments for people of Kashmir after witnessing the grave atrocities and Human Rights violations committed by Indian Forces.



Masarrat Aalam Welcomes OIC Secretary General's Strongly-Worded Statement On Kashmir

The illegally detained All Parties Hurriyat Conference Chairman Masarrat Aalam Butt, while welcoming the OIC Secretary General's strongly-worded statement on Kashmir, has hoped that the Muslim countries will collectively raise their voice for the right to self-determination of the Kashmiri people. In a statement, he said the time has come when New Delhi should be given a shut-up call for practicing brutal methods of coercion to punish the Kashmiris for demanding the UN-guaranteed right. The APHC chairman said India is subjecting Hurriyat leaders, media persons, rights activists and even ordinary youth to illegal arrests in fake cases to break their resolve for freedom.



OIC Assistant Secretary General Briefed On Indian Machinations In IIOJK

All Parties Hurriyat Conference-AJK delegation headed by Convener Mehmood Ahmed Saghar met OIC Assistant Secretary General, Yousef Aldoubeay in Islamabad, and presented him a memorandum on India's anti-Kashmiris' measures in Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir (IIOJK). The delegation apprised him about Indian human rights violations, demographic changes, gerrymandering in the name of delimitation of assembly constituencies and land grab in the occupied territory. The OIC dignitary was also informed about banning of religious and political organizations and closure of schools putting education of thousands of students at risk.



Indian Troops Martyr Four Kashmiri Youth in IIOJK

In Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir (IIOJK), Indian troops in their fresh act of state terrorism martyred four Kashmiri youth in a fake encounter in Jammu district. According to Kashmir Media Service, the troops martyred the youth after dislodging them

from a vehicle they were travelling in and killed them in cold-blood in Sidhra area of the district. Later, Indian army portrayed them as militants, who it claimed were killed in a clash during a cordon and search operation. However, eyewitnesses said that the martyred youth were civilians and were killed in a staged encounter by the troops. Meanwhile, Indian authorities have imposed restrictions under section 144 in Pattan area of Baramulla district to prevent a Muslim religious programme.

IIOJK: Modi Regime Intensifies Crackdown to Seize Kashmiris' Properties

The Modi-led fascist Indian regime has intensified crackdown to seize properties of the Kashmiris to muzzle their voice for freedom. India in its latest wave of confiscations has seized properties worth million of rupees of Jamaat-e-Islami and other pro-freedom Kashmiris as part of political vendetta. Nearly 250 more assets of pro-freedom people and Jamaat-e-Islami are under the radar of Indian agencies for seizure.



Democracy Suspended In IIOJK: Mehbooba Mufti

The President of Peoples Democratic Party Mehbooba Mufti has said that democracy has been suspended in the territory. Talking to media in Srinagar, she said the fundamental rights of people have been suspended. If anyone talks, he is arrested, be it a journalist or a common man. Politicians are pressured through the Indian Enforcement Directorate or other agencies and they are facing difficulties in playing their role. Mehbooba Mufti said jails are filled with the people from IIOJK. She said the BJP has ruined the atmosphere in the country.

APHC Strongly Condemns Killing Of Four Kashmiri Youth By Indian Troops In Fake Encounter In IIOJK

The APHC strongly condemning the killing of four Kashmiri youth by Indian troops in a fake encounter in Jammu district has urged the world community to hold India accountable for its brutalities in the occupied territory. In a statement, the incarcerated APHC leader, Shabbir Ahmad Shah said the troops dislodged the youth from a vehicle and killed them cold-bloodedly in Sidhra area of the district. He said the incident is yet another addition to the unending chronicles of staged encounters that have become a new normal in the territory. He said Narendra Modi-led racist Indian regime has intensified its state terrorism in the occupied territory to suppress the Kashmiris' ongoing freedom movement. Meanwhile, the occupation authorities in a major crackdown on the assets of Jamaat-e-Islami and other pro-freedom people have intensified the drive to seize their properties in the territory. On the other hand, the Peoples Democratic Party chief, Mehbooba Mufti, talking to media-men in Srinagar, said democracy has been suspended in the occupied territory.



Modi Regime Demolishes House Of Prominent Freedom Leader In IIOJK

In Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir, the fascist Modi-led Indian regime has demolished the house of a prominent freedom leader Amir Khan in Islamabad district. The house was demolished by the Modi regime to harass and create a sense of fear among the locals in Pahalgam area of the district.

Modi's Militaristic Approach Made Kashmir Dispute Nuclear Flashpoint: APHC

All Parties Hurriyat Conference leaders have said Narendra Modi's militaristic approach has made the Kashmir dispute a nuclear flashpoint putting the peace of entire South Asia at stake. According to Kashmir Media Service, APHC leaders Ghulam Ahmad Gulzar, Ghulam Muhammad Khan Sopori, Bilal Siddiqi, Zamruda Habib, Yasmeen Raja, Farida Bahenji and Dr Musaib in their separate statements in Srinagar said Jammu and Kashmir is not a law and order issue but it pertains to the right to self-determination of around 15 million people. Senior APHC-AJK leader, Muhammad Farooq Rehmani, in a statement in Islamabad urged the United Nations to form a special committee to probe the Modi-led Hindutva regime's racist policies in occupied territory.

Ankara Declaration Rejects India's Illegal Occupation, Denial Of Self-Determination To Kashmiris

The Legal Forum for Kashmir has released the "Ankara Declaration" rejecting India's illegal occupation and denial of self-determination to Kashmiris. The Legal Forum for Kashmir in collaboration with Centre for Economic and Social Research, organized a three-day "International Kashmir Congress" in Ankara, Turkey. A declaration released on the occasion said the representatives of the people of Indian Occupied Jammu and Kashmir, along with those in solidarity in Ankara, Turkiye solemnly declare that international community has failed in providing justice and protecting the people of Indian occupied Kashmir for many decades. The declaration said India has flagrantly violated international law, norms, conventions, and treaties in the course of implementation and its unlawful occupation, with the criminal intention of colonizing and annexing Kashmir. It said the Indian state is aggressively pursuing a fascist agenda in occupied Kashmir and has been perpetrating the war crimes, crime against humanity and crime of aggression and doing so with total impunity and zero accountability.



APHC Leader Urges World To Take Note Of Fast Deteriorating HR Situation In IIOJK

Incarcerated senior leader of All Parties Hurriyat Conference, Shabbir Ahmed Shah, has urged the international community to take cognizance of the fast deteriorating human rights situation in Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir. In his message from New Delhi's Tihar jail, he said the people of occupied territory have been facing the worst Indian state terrorism for the last over seven decades. Shabbir Ahmed Shah said India's continuous denial to grant the Kashmiris their birth right has prevented them from enjoying the benefits of freedom as enshrined in the UN charter, the Geneva Convention and other core international human rights treaties.



IIOJK: DFP Expresses Concern Over Worsening HR Situation In Territory

The Jammu and Kashmir Democratic Freedom Party, headed by incarcerated senior APHC leader Shabbir Ahmad Shah, has expressed grave concern over the worsening human rights situation in the territory. In a statement issued in Srinagar, the DFP said that the Narendra Modi-led fascist Indian government had intensified its brutalities against the Kashmiris to

punish them for challenging India's illegal occupation of Jammu and Kashmir. Meanwhile, Delhi-controlled State Investigation Agency seized more properties of Jamaat-e-Islami in several districts of the Kashmir Valley including Ganderbal, Kupwara, Bandipora and Baramulla. Meanwhile, in their interviews and statements in Srinagar, political experts and analysts said that the Narendra Modi-led fascist Indian government was forcefully implementing the nefarious agenda of RSS to colonize occupied Jammu and Kashmir and change its demographic composition.

World Community Failed To Ensure Justice, Freedom On Equitable Basis: KDC

Kashmir Diaspora Council says the ongoing all-out war against people in Indian Illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir is due to a failure of the international system to ensure justice and freedom on equitable basis. In a statement, Vice Chairman of KDC and President of Istanbul-based Kashmir House Dr. Mubeen Shah, while condemning murder, loot and destruction of private properties in the occupied territory by the Indian forces, called on international community to wake up to the realities on the ground and act decisively and fast to protect Kashmiri people against Indian onslaught. He said there is no reason for the international community to close its eyes on what is happening in the territory and that is why Kashmiris want international community to act fast and hold India accountable for its war crimes.



IIOJK: OIC Chief Urged To Come Up With Plan To Rein In India

All Parties Hurriyat Conference has called upon the Secretary General of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation, Hissein Brahim Taha, to come up with a collective policy endorsed by all member countries to conduct a political and economic boycott of India for its disastrous plan for Muslims in India and occupied Jammu and Kashmir. Appeal has been made ahead of a three-day visit of OIC chief Hissein Brahim Taha along with a delegation to Pakistan and Azad Jammu and Kashmir. The APHC spokesman said Modi-led fascist regime is all set to exterminate Muslims in India and occupied Jammu and Kashmir. People held protest demonstrations against the authorities' anti-people policies in Baramulla and different areas of Jammu.



Modi's G20 Policy Can Do Wonders If Applied To Kashmir: Mirwaiz

Senior leader of the All Parties Hurriyat Conference, Mirwaiz Umar Farooq while exposing the contradiction of the policy, outlined by Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi in an article describing the 'G20 scenario' under Indian presidency, has said the same can work wonders if adopted in dealing with the Kashmir dispute. Mirwaiz Umar Farooq who continues to remain under house arrest in a statement in Srinagar making a reference to the outstanding Kashmir dispute said problems and disputes have to be resolved sooner or later and peaceful negotiations provide the best option.



Mehbooba To Raise Concern Against Modi's Plan To Create Database Of All Families In IIOJK

People's Democratic Party Chief Mehbooba Mufti has joined other political parties and groups to raise concern against the Modi regime's plan to create database of all families. Mehbooba Mufti in a tweet said the plan to create unique IDs for all families is another surveillance tactic to tighten the iron grip on the lives of Kashmir residents.

Protest Held Against Killing Of Two Locals By Indian Troops In Rajouri

In Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir (IIOJK), a massive protest was held against the killing of two locals near an Indian army camp in Rajouri district. Police officials said the victims, who were working as porters with the Indian Army, were entering the Army camp when they were fired upon by the troops.

Farooq Warns Modi Regime, Army against Interfering, Rigging In IIOJK Election

National Conference President Dr Farooq Abdullah has warned the Modi regime and its armed forces against interfering in the sham election process in the territory.
